**Fishing and casting**  
**2022 / 2023**

**Casting club Day Sunday 11th September**

Venue to be advised, casting will commence at 9am, to be eligible for the Champion of Champions trophy members must participate in at least one casting event. Your best result of any one of the casting events will count towards our casting trophies and these points will be added to your field weekend points table.

**Streetwise Field weekend One September 30th, October 1st<sup>th</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> (Open)**

On an open boundary weekend, there are no club boundaries. You can fish anywhere in NZ (salt water only) start fish time will be 5pm Friday regardless where you fish Weigh in for these weekends will be at 2pm Sunday at the usual venue. Please ensure to observe MPI catch limits and restrictions for the area you fish in.

Any fish caught outside the normal club's boundaries will qualify for pins and points but will not qualify for club records.

**Rivers to Ranges Field weekend two October 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> (7Up Challenge)**

Start fish time 5am Saturday. Weigh in is 12pm (midday) Sunday. Normal boundaries apply. A bonus 200 points if 7 or more fish are weighed in

**Kahawai Competition Sunday October 23<sup>rd</sup>**

**Casting October 30<sup>th</sup> (Postal casting)**

Venue to be advised, casting will commence at 9am,  
Casting on the day will consist of three accuracy casts and three distance casts  
Postal casting results are then forwarded to our national body NZACA

**Craftys Field weekend Three November 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> (Red Weight Challenge)**

Your heaviest Snapper and/or gurnard in your bag will earn Double points  
The weekend will start 5pm Friday, normal boundaries apply and the weigh in will be at the fire station 12pm midday Sunday.

**Hunting & Fishing Field weekend Four November 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> (Pick a Quinella)**

Start fish time 5pm Friday night. Weigh in is 12pm (midday) Sunday at the fire station. Normal boundaries apply.

For each Kahawai matched with a Moki or Trevally an additional 75 points will be added

**Rockgas HB Field weekend Five December 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> (Ham's weekend)**

This weekend has normal club boundaries, start fish time of 5pm Friday, and weigh in at 12pm (midday Sunday) at the normal venue. There is a \$10 per rod entry fee which must be paid prior to start fish time. All major prizes will be hams but everybody who enters will receive a prize.

**Hamills Field weekend Six January 20<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> (Bag Limit Challenge)**

Start fish time of 5pm Friday, normal boundaries apply and weigh in will be held at the fire station 12pm (midday Sunday)

You will receive an extra 40 points per fish of the species that you have bagged out

**Fishbites.com Field weekend seven February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> (Variety Challenge)**

A start fish time of 5pm Friday night. Weigh in is 12pm (midday) Sunday. Normal boundaries apply.

An additional 300 points will be awarded for 3 different species, 400 for 4 species 500 for 5 species

Any weighable fish over 2.5kg will receive an additional 75 points per 2.5+kg fish  
This challenge excludes SSH

Start fish time of 5pm Friday, normal boundaries apply, weigh in at the fire station 12pm (midday Sunday)

### **Hunting & Fishing Field weekend ten April 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> (Pin Challenge)**

Any pin fish weighed in will receive an **additional 200 points** with a maximum of three pins, (must be 3 different species to qualify for additional points)

Start fish time of 5pm Friday, normal boundaries apply, weigh in at the fire station  
12pm (midday Sunday)

### **Hamills Field weekend Eleven April 29<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> (The Humble Kahawai)**

Start fish time of 5am Saturday, normal boundaries apply, weigh in at the fire station  
12pm (midday Sunday)

5 weighable Kahawai will earn you **250 points**

### **Casting May 7<sup>th</sup> (Club casting)**
